



Deputy Ricky Brown has probable cause to believe that **Derrick Williamson** did commit the offense of **OBSTRUCTION OF OFFICERS-MISD O.C.G.A 16-10-24(A)**, when he knowingly and willfully obstructed **Deputy Brown's** detainment by resisting and failing to comply to lawful orders given. **TO WIT: Deputy Ricky Brown** advised **Derrick Williamson** that he would be detained due to a physical altercation that had taken place prior to officer arrival. Detainment would have ensured the safety of **Mr. Williamson** and others until an investigation of the incident was finalized. During the detainment **Mr. Williamson** became more irate and failed to comply to verbal commands consequently having to be taken to the ground and apprehended. During the resistance from **Mr. Williamson**, **Deputy Brown's** glasses were broken as a result to his lack of compliance.
