Upon my arrival, I met with the complainant, Mrs. Janet Hardee. Mrs. Hardee stated that Mr. Derrick Williamson had gone online prior to deputies arriving at the residence on October 23, 2022 broadcasting over FaceBook Live talking about the current turmoil at the residence. During and after the live broadcast, some individuals had made comments and vague threats in reference to the other parties that live on premises. Mrs. Hardee provided me three pieces of paper with screen shots of the comments that were posted to Mr. Williamson's video. In the screen shots, two subjects named Bobby Aguiniga and Keiita Key had made comments that were cause for concern to Mrs. Hardee which she had marked on the paper prior to my arrival.

Bobby commented "Give me your address I will remove them" and "Dude we need to come......." And Keiita commented "They going to make me pull up and slap the white off they ass they got you fucked up". Another party named Michelle Larkin had made comments defending the Hardee family to which Keiita made the following comments, "Michelle Larkin y`all can`t leave cause y`all homeless kmsl yall look like bombs go get a fucking life" and "Michelle Larkin speaking on my brother and his daughter will get your ass seen about real quick my pull up game strong ASF leave my brother alone that's your last time just know I`ll do time behind him". All quotes are exactly how the text reads on the papers provided.

Mrs. Hardee turned over the paper copies she brought to the Sheriff's Office to me to enter into a case folder. Once I collected the papers, I handed Mrs. Hardee a contact card with this case number written on it. As of October 26, 2022 at 1:30 a.m., the video is still posted to Mr. Williamson's FaceBook page and available for public view to include the comments already noted in this report as well as other comments.
